## Shooting

There will be 4 archers per target for the WA 70 and 60 with 2 archers per target for compound archers who choose to shoot the WA 50. All shooting will be in 2 details with ends of 6 arrows to be shot in 4 timed minutes.

## Record Status

This competition will be liable for DRUG testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors must have written parental consent. (This is given by a parent signing the entry form)

## Arrows

The venue is a public field so we would prefer that no "all carbon" arrows are used. If you do intend to shoot "all carbon" arrows then please state on the entry form how to find them if they end up in the grass.

## Competitors

You must conform to correct Archery GB dress regulations (307). Only members of Archery GB or World Archery are permitted to shoot at the tournament.
