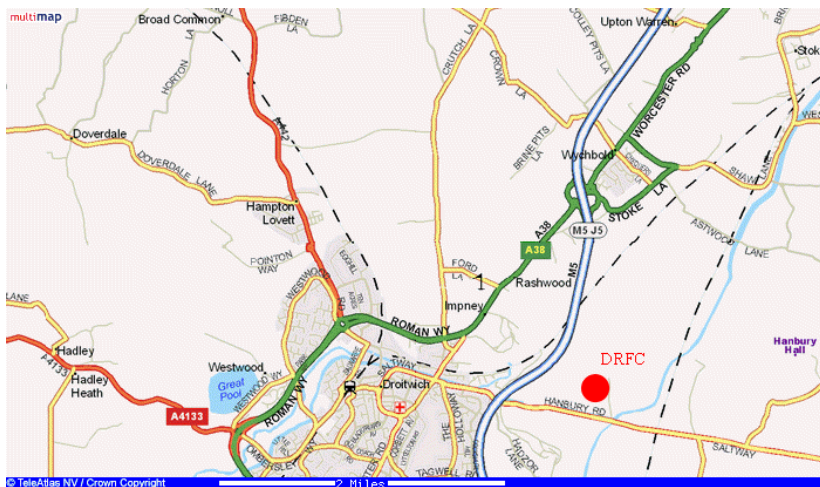


**Droitwich Archery Society

ROUND	Albion / Windsor: 3 dozen at each of the ranges shown below: Seniors (Ladies & Gents): Albion 80/60/50 yds U18 (Ladies & Gents): Windsor 60/50/40 yds U16 (Ladies & Gents): Short Windsor 50/40/30 yds U14 (Ladies & Gents): Junior Windsor 40/30/20 yds U12 (Ladies & Gents): Short Junior Windsor 30/20/10 yds Visually impaired: Burntwood Albion 30/30/30 yds Unsighted bows: 1 range shorter. Any archer upon request:: St George 100/80/60 yds Archers are welcome to shoot <i>any</i> round, but trophies will only be awarded at the distances above (or longer). Archers wishing to shoot <i>other</i> than in their allocated round are asked to draw attention to this on their entry form. Juniors wishing to compete for senior trophies must pay the senior fee & state this clearly on the entry form.

AWARDS	Trophies, medals and classification medals for Seniors and Juniors in Longbow, Recurve and Compound Divisions and, if appropriate, in other bow classes. The number of awards will be subject to entry.
TEAM AWARD	The team trophy will be awarded to a team of four archers composed as follows: At least one lady, maximum of two juniors. Compounds will be handicapped as per WM Summer League rules. All team members must have shot at (or above) their allocated round (see above)
