- 1.All archers must be affiliated to Archery GB or a World Archery Member Association and they will be asked to produce their membership cards.
- 2.Awards will be made to WMAS, CWAA and Open depending on entries. Second rounds shot will not be eligible for awards.
- 3.Two practice ends will be shot at the start of each WA 18m round.
- 4.Triple vertical faces will be used on foam bosses.
- 5.Shooting: Four archers per boss in two details of two, timed ends of 3 arrows in 2 minutes, with lights
- 6.Archery GB dress regulations will apply. Soft soled shoes must be worn.
- 7.Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors' entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached.
- 8.The organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or personal possessions.
- 9.Any person wishing to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Organiser.
- 10.Due to limited space in the hall, spectators may only watch from the viewing gallery.
- 11.No food or drinks are available for purchase in the venue.
