### PROSPECTUS

<b>Location:</b>	Deer Park Ground, off Shurdington Rd, Shurdington, Cheltenham GL51 4UE
<b>Round:</b>	Recurves: qualifying round WA 60m for Cadets (up to and in the year of their 17th birthday) and 70m for all other archers; Compounds: WA 50m for all ages. Head-to-heads in all disciplines. Barebow and Longbow archers are welcome to enter, but will be treated as recurves for the head-to-heads.

<b>Registration:</b>	Registration will be open from 8.00am. Membership cards will be required for booking in. If you are not yet in possession of a valid card, please bring proof that you have paid your membership to your club.
<b>Event Timings:</b>	Assembly at 8.45am followed by 45 minutes of Practise which will include equipment inspection. The Tournament will commence immediately after.
<b>Event Format:</b>	Rounds will be shot in accordance with WA Rules of Shooting. Music will be played between ends. All archers will shoot on layered foam bosses.
<b>Awards:</b>	Awards will be presented for the winners of each head 2 head category.
<b>Dress:</b>	Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations. Archers should comply with dress regulations until after the presentations.
<b>Lost Arrows:</b>	Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find them). It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.
<b>Drug Testing:</b>	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable to drug testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. By entering the tournament Parents / Guardians are giving consent for junior archers (under 18's) to be drug tested if approached.
<b>Refreshments:</b>	Hot & cold food and drinks will be available.
<b>Photography:</b>	People wishing to take photographs during the tournament must register their details with the Tournament Organiser. If parents/carers have any particular concern about their child / young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the Tournament Organisers.

<b>Notes:</b>	<p>Archers who are unable to get to the target should discuss their specific requirements with the Tournament Organiser.
