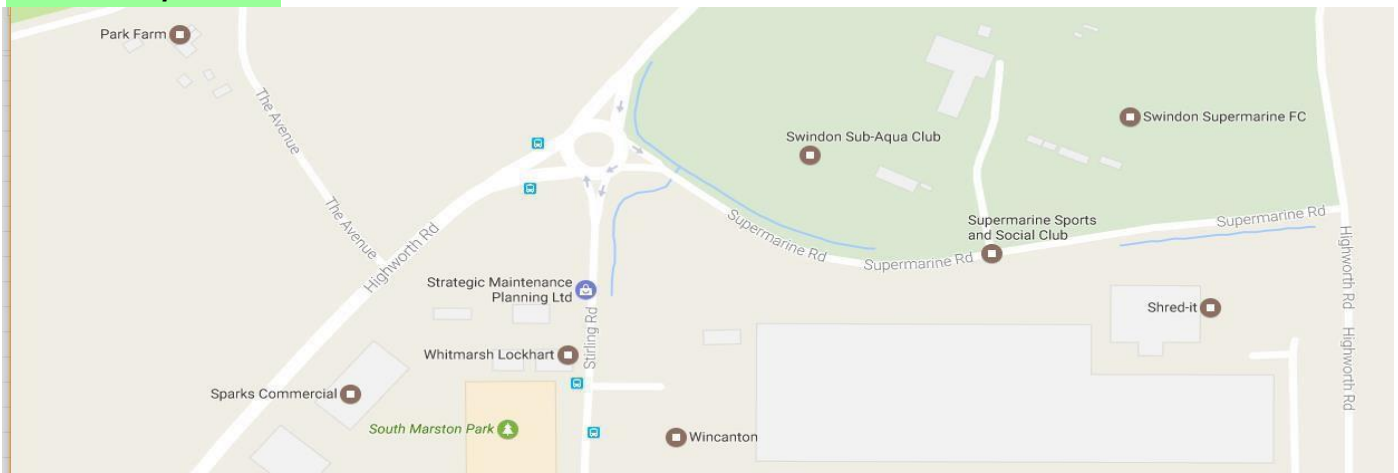

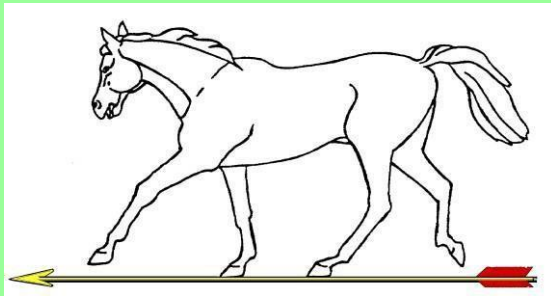

Awards	Medals will be awarded for First, Second and Third place in each category. Awards will be made based on the highest scoring SINGLE ROUNDS

Drug Testing	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drug testing. Competitors who are approached to provide samples must comply. Location Map





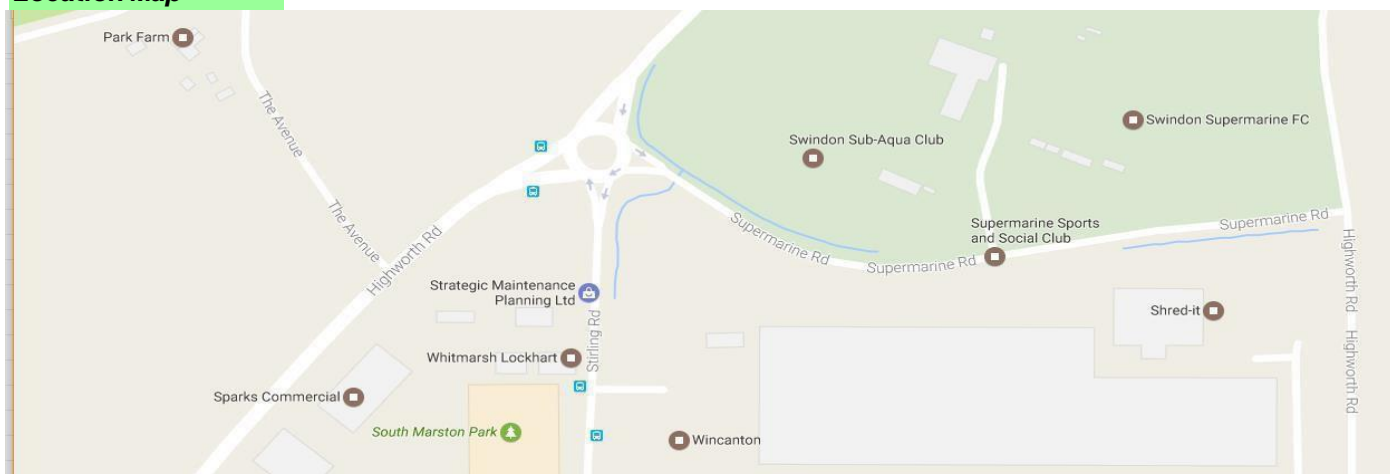

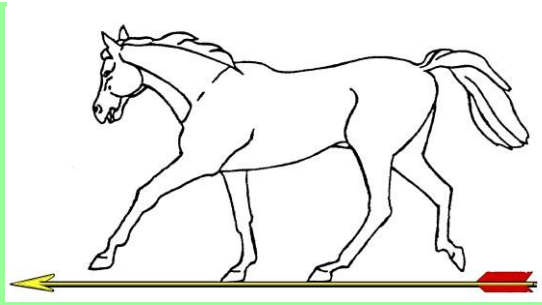
